The Sonic All-College Basketball Classic will be played on Dec. 21, 2009, at the Ford Center. The doubleheader will feature the University of Oklahoma versus the University of Texas at El Paso at 5:30 p.m. followed by Oklahoma State University playing the La Salle Explorers at 7:30 p.m. Both games will be televised on ESPN2HD.
